ADMISSION TO RECEPTION, AUTUMN TERM 2019

Information about waiting lists, appeals and the breakdown of allocations for community schools, academies and free schools in Enfield

The Local Authority (LA) is responsible for deciding how places are allocated at community primary schools. For academies, free schools and voluntary aided (faith) schools the governors, academy council or trust of the relevant school are responsible for deciding how places should be allocated. When considering applications the relevant admission authority uses the published admissions criteria to decide which children are offered places.

The admissions criteria for Enfield schools are published in the booklet 'Applying for a Primary School in Enfield' which is available online at www.enfield.gov.uk/admissions or given to you. It also explains how applications are considered. Information about admission arrangements for schools in other authorities can be obtained from them directly.

Accepting your offer

If you applied online you can accept your place by logging onto your eadmissions account. You need to do this by 30 April 2019. We advise you accept the place offered even if you wish to pursue higher preference schools.

Waiting Lists

All oversubscribed Enfield Schools have waiting lists. Your child's name has automatically been included on the waiting list for any Enfield school(s) that were a higher preference than the school you have been offered.

If you live in Enfield, details of your child's position on the waiting list for the following schools will be in the letter you receive: Ark John Keats Academy, Bowes-Bowes Road, Brettenham, Carterhatch, Chase Side, Enfield Heights Academy, Eversley, Firs Farm, Galliard, George Spicer, Hadley Wood, Hazelwood, Highfield, Kingfisher Hall, Lavender, Merryhills, Oakthorpe, Raglan, Walker and Worcesters.

Applying for additional schools

If you now want to apply for a different school than the one you have been offered you will need to complete a PR2 form. This form must be used to apply for all Enfield schools or any schools outside the Borough. Please complete the PR2 form and either scan and email it to esas@enfield.gov.uk or post to ESAS, Civic Centre, Silver Street, EN1 3XA by 3 May 2019. No places will be offered from the waiting lists until 3 May at the earliest.

Appeals

- You have the right to appeal against the decision not to offer your child a place at a school
 of your preference. Your right of appeal is in accordance with the School Standards and
 Framework Act 1998. Please note that the majority of appeals will be heard in accordance
 with the class size legislation restrictions.
- Appeal forms for community schools are available from the Enfield Schools Admission
 Service and can be downloaded from the Enfield website www.enfield.gov.uk/admissions.
 Appeal forms for community schools must be returned by 17 May 2019. You need to
 contact own admission authority schools directly for appeal forms and further information
 about their appeal arrangements as their timetable may be different.
